

OPEN CALL FOR NC3 CREW VOLUNTEERS

Crew members work three, 4-hour shifts assisting in essential conference tasks ranging from mixing sand and installing exhibitions, to watching gates and making coffee!

In exchange for volunteer time, accepted NC3 Crew members receive a \$25 registration rate.

We are seeking applications for NC3 Crew positions in the following areas:

Workshops

- Mixing & packing sand
- Cleaning & putting away tools
- Checking in with workshop instructors
- Helping with production pour preparations

Molds

- Assist at the 'mold intake station', palletizing brought molds to be taken to guest furnaces
- Enuring guest furnaces have an appropriate and feasible number of molds
- Assist with 'weigh out station' at the end of the conference, weighing and taking payments for materials

Exhibitions

- Assist with art intake and pickup
- Assist Exhibitions Team with installation, pedestal and wall refinishing, and site cleanup

Shuttle and Hospitality

- Drive a golf cart shuttle service
- Manage the Artist Hospitality Tent (making coffee, restocking water/soft drinks and snacks)
- Managing the Registration Table
- Trash runs
- Occasionally watching the field or main entry gate if needed for load in/out
- Help flip tables and chairs between programming

Float

- Ready to fill in any areas that need additional help
- Support for demonstrations and performances as needed
- "Flipping" areas between programming
